This hard work shows itself in the "Mr. K" Memorial Camp Scholarship Program.

The Michigan Associations of Student Councils and Honor Societies (MASC/MAHS) lost a dear friend in February 2007. Mr. Jack Kalousek taught and advised at Franklin High School (Livonia, Michigan) for 12 years and was serving as their Student Activities Director. He was passionate about student leadership and providing students opportunities to grow. His involvement at the local, state and national level was matched by very few advisers in Michigan. He was well-known, respected, loved and treasured by advisers and students throughout Michigan and he will continue to be dearly missed. After Jack's passing, numerous schools and individuals came forward to donate money to the Association in the hope that a scholarship for the Summer Leadership Camp could be put together. In recent years, volunteers and friends of MASC/MAHS camps have continued fundraising efforts to sustain the scholarship program. The Kalousek Family agreed that Jack's passion was seeing students grow and encouraged the creation of the "Mr. K" Memorial Camp Scholarship Program.

These scholarships will be awarded to student leaders from any public or private high school in Michigan that are **currently in** (2010-2011) 6th-11th grade and are interested in attending one of the MASC/MAHS Summer Leadership Camps. The student's school **must** be a member of MASC/MAHS. Eligible and interested students must submit a completed Applicant Overview Form (see page 2), as well as a personal essay in order to be considered for a scholarship.

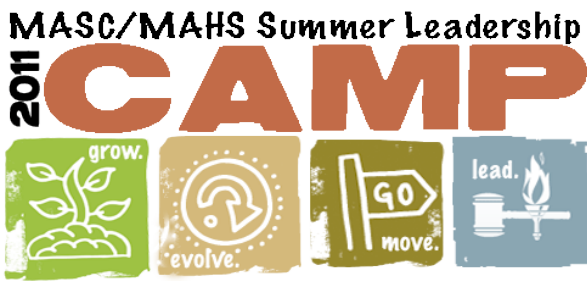
Scholarships will cover a portion of the Camp Registration Fee (the portion depends on the response of qualified applicants and available donations for the year), however--it should not be expected that the scholarship will cover the entire registration cost. The student is responsible for paying the remainder of the cost of camp pursuant to the deadlines in the registration materials unless written arrangements have been agreed to and made with MASSP/MASC/MAHS.
