### **Michigan Student Leadership State Conference**

- Creating a system of registration that allows for all schools to be represented at the state conference
- All materials for registration need to be released earlier
- Registration procedure for the state conference will be released in the June issue of Leadlines; this includes all deadlines, registration timelines and hotel information as approved by the Adviser Board
- Improvements to be made:  
Decrease “dead-time” for students and advisers; Restructure the Center Meeting time, more center-focused activities; Board of Delegate process and procedure; Have all materials schools need already at GTR, hard for schools to bring additional supplies; Grand Traverse Resort-food delivery, bathroom issue

### **Revision Ideas for MASC/MAHS Michigan Student Leadership Awards**

- AOE: changing the focus of the award, new categories to consider, focus areas should not follow a “one-size fits all” approach
- AOE should be a document to follow all year-long
- Ask recipients of AOE if MASC/MAHS can post their awards online for examples of excellence
- All awards should have the ability to be digitally submitted
- Process for digitally submitting awards and updated award process will be released in the fall of 2014

### **Summer Camp**

- Updated subpages, registration process is online
- SETSEG had over 270 scholarship applications, have sent out congrats letters to 70 students
- “Mr. K” scholarship is still available for summer camp
